

Fires and Fireworks risk lives and homes!



- **No wood fires or fireworks ANYWHERE in Kiwanda Shores or on the upper beach**
- **Per Tillamook County restrictions:**
 - **Fires on lower beach only**
 - **At least 50 feet from any vegetation or piles of driftwood**

Open fires and fireworks are banned within Kiwanda Shores, whether on a private lot or in the common areas. This includes the elevated sand dune between and in front of the beachfront homes. The beach grass is extremely flammable and fire can spread uncontrollably within minutes. If you wish to use legal fireworks, please do so on the lower beach only.

Other hazards: anything that emits sparks or embers. Propane stoves and devices with a shutoff valve are allowed. Our by-laws allow for charcoal briquette BBQs. Use them carefully under close supervision away from the grass. Do not drive on dry grass or brush; an exhaust pipe or muffler can start fires you won't see.

If you see a fire or fire risk:

- If the fire is active or the risk is immediate, call 911
- If there is no one around and it is not an emergency, call the non-emergency local sheriff: 503-815-1911
- If people are there, let them know that fires are allowed on the lower beach only
